- Young ladies wearing children's sizes: Body Wrappers C45 in ballet pink.
- Ladies wearing adult sizes: Body Wrappers A45 in ballet pink.
- Young ladies selecting darker tones instead of ballet pink: Total Stretch convertible tights, style C81; coffee, jazzy tan, light suntan, tan as best matches your skin tone and shoes.
- Ladies wearing adult sizes and selecting darker tones instead of ballet pink: Total Stretch convertible tights, style C81; coffee, jazzy tan, light suntan, tan as best matches your skin tone and shoes.
- Buy at least two pairs!
- Boys/Men, please buy a package of black socks and black ballet shoes.

### **Performance Hair**

- Students will be instructed about their hair style (high bun, low bun, etc) in class.
- Ladies need a package of bobby pins matching their hair color and hair nets.
- Men with long hair must have hair smoothly tied back.
